The Court already explained why Plaintiff cannot unilaterally dismiss this action. *See* Doc. [38] (citing *Welsh v. Correct Care, L.L.C.*, 915 F.3d 341, 344 (5th Cir. 2019) (filing of an amended complaint does not revive the plaintiff’s absolute right to dismissal under Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(i))).


Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is directed to **STRIKE** Plaintiff’s Second Notice of Voluntary Dismissal. Doc. [39].

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall read the entirety of the Court’s Memorandum and Order, Doc. [38], and the cases cited therein prior to filing any motions or other papers related to dismissal.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that Plaintiff still must abide by the previously ordered deadlines. The failure to do so could result in sanctions as described in the First Amended Case Management Order. *See* Doc. [34].
